If we do not raise the £5,000 needed then there will be no crossing patrol warden on the corner from September 2020.

This year, we are asking parents to play the giant inter-school raffle online, via justgiving.

Again, we will not ask you to give up your time and attend events. We will not constantly bombard you with pleas to help throughout the year. We are just three busy parents attempting to coordinate one, sustainable fundraising idea to save the crossing and we need EVERY family to get behind it and help us.

This, very importantly, allows you to share the link with friends/family/your own network to broaden our fundraising net. Please send the link to anyone in your circle who you think will support the kids by buying a ticket or two.

The raffle will run from NOW until April 1. Every £1 donated = one entry into the raffle.

Please make sure you read all the information on the justgiving page before donating. You MUST tick the email box (so we can get in touch with you to claim your prize) and name your associated school in the comments box.

Like last year, in the sad event we do not raise the £5,000 necessary from this raffle then all monies raised will be gifted back to your school, via your PTFA, so you must tell us which school you would like this to be while making a donation.

If you are unwilling to play online, you can purchase traditional raffle tickets over the bar at City of Newcastle golf club on the Great North Road and at Coppers 8-8 store on Brunton Park.

Thanks in advance for making ours the only school crossing patrol saved by its community every year since the City Council first axed their funding in 2017.
