

### **Dear Parents**

Our wonderful Year 3 and Year 4 children will be having a special day of outdoor learning with a '24 hour residential' on site. This will be delivered by *Mr H* from *Outdoor experiences*. Our Year 3 and Year 4 children will have a day packed with fun activities (see below) followed by an overnight stay in a tent on the school field. There will be at least three members of GPFS staff on site afterschool and throughout the night, in addition to Mr H and one of his staff. The children will sleep in tents in groups of four and will only need to bring a sleeping bag and ground mat or blanket and a pillow.

# Day 1

9:15 - 4:25

The children will be put into groups and will take part in the following activities

- Activity 1 = 3D maps of the school site using natural materials and treasure hunt using their maps
- Activity 2 = Orienteering
- Activity 3 = Making clay nature models
- Activity 4 = Archery (soft)
- Activity 5 = Fire lighting and backwoods cooking
- Activity 6 = Assault course
- Activity 7 = Circus Training

16:25 - 17:30 = Pizza Party and ice creams! There will be an alternative option for anyone who doesn't like pizza.

17:40 – 18:40 = Campfire songs and hot chocolate (hopefully with marshmallows!)
