
#### Sainsbury's Vouchers

Numicon is a multi-sensory approach to teaching maths developed by experts in the classroom. It is designed to help children understand connections between numbers. Through the multi-sensory activities and mathematical language of Numicon, children develop the understanding and skills that underpin their understanding of number.
