

Following feedback regarding the family maths scrapbooks activities last term, staff will be choosing the next activity very carefully to make sure it is fun and easy to follow and where appropriate will give some tips on how to go about solving the activity.

We also know parents are very keen to support at home and want to make sure they are using the correct strategies and methods. We know the children tell you off if they don't think you are doing it the 'right' way. There are two documents, one which shows the strategies and the other which gives information on which strategies are most appropriate for each year group.
