Topics and Holiday Research Projects

Our topics for next half term are:

Early Years — What a Wonderful World



What a Wonderful World exposes our children to the world beyond their doorstep through a rich curriculum of stories and experiences from other cultures. Children explain similarities and differences between life in this country and life in other countries, drawing on knowledge from stories, non-fiction texts and maps.

KS1 –

Fire, Fire!

Children in Key Stage One are introduced to the historical concept of cause and consequence through learning about the Great Fire of London. We explore reasons why the fire occurred, changes between London in 1666 and the modern day and the compare this significant event to the local 'Great Fire' of Newcastle and Gateshead.

KS2 – Victorians




Key Stage Two are transported back in time to Victorian Britain to learn about this significant time period and its impact within our locality. Children will be interpreting historical evidence, visiting Beamish Museum, designing William Morris prints and taking a closer look at what life was like for Victorian children.

Reading at Gosforth Park



We love reading at Gosforth Park First School and have enjoyed some wonderful books this half term.



Reception have really enjoyed exploring their feelings with the Colour Monster, discussing families in Owl Babies and they got into the spooky season early this year with Funnybones!



KS1 have absolutely loved their Pirate topic and the fabulous books to match. We sailed away on an adventure with The Night Pirates, discovered some amazing facts in Meet the Pirates and re-told the fabulously funny story of Pirates Love Underpants!

Late pickups

If you are going to be late to collect your child, please call the wraparound mobile and let a member of staff know as soon as possible as this can affect our staff/pupil ratios and may mean that one or more members of staff cannot leave at their normal finish time. This unfortunately also means that you will incur late fees, as we will be required to cover the staff overtime costs. The fees are as follows;
