### Eating your Greens!

So, it's nearly time for that once a year, often feared and reviled by many, little green ball of goodness - the humble SPROUT! Sprouts can be rejected before they've even made it home from the supermarket and the fact that they can be very bitter is usually why. So how do we get our little ones to even try vegetables such as sprouts? Firstly, the bitterness can be subdued by adding some butter and a small amount of bacon. The bacon can be cooked in advance and added to butter once cooled. It can then be used to melt on top of the bitter veg on the day. Sprouts or other greens such as cabbage or kale can also be shredded and fried or roasted with garlic and parmesan. It really is worth a try. How about renaming them Shrek's snacks or Ogre buttons or get the children to help decorate them once cooked, using cocktail sticks to add sticky festive cranberries. As a sprout hider as a child (think – under Dad's mash or into a nearby plant pot!) bacon and chestnut butter was my turning point and I'll now eat them without a fuss.

So there is still hope!
