Thank you so much for you support in ensuring that, when well enough, children are here and on time!

Thanks to your support our whole school attendance to date is 97.4% which is up from 96.8% last year.

- If you do require a leave of absence due to exceptional circumstances this can only be granted by the headteacher. Please pick up a leave of absensce form from the office and pop in to see Mrs Sara to discuss.
- If your child has a medical appointment, please speak to school office staff as you will need to get a pass and if possible please show your appointment card or letter.
- If it is an urgent appointment to see your child's GP then please inform the office staff as we are legally required to record all absences and state reasons for absence.
- If your child is absent due to illness you must contact the School Office first thing in the morning and state the nature of the illness e.g. virus, sickness etc.
- If your child is absent for another reason please still ring and we will endeavour to help. We do know that emergencies and other issues can arise.
- If your child is late, please bring them to the office and complete the late form.
