End of School Day Pick up – Urgent Help with this please

Next week KS1 children will be collected from the outside entrance door near their classrooms. KS1 will be brought to the doors by their class teachers and handed over to you. This will be at 3.25pm. KS2 will be brought to the entrance doors at 3.30pm by their class teachers. If you are late or can't collect your child and arrange for someone else known to your child to do this eg an adult; you <u>must</u> inform the school office. Children cannot come and pick up siblings from school, as a guide they should be eg 15 years or older (NSPCC advice).

SECURITY – Your Help is Needed

- 1. **Outside gates** we need your help. Please ensure that they are closed. There are signs on them. Your support with this is much appreciated.
- 2. **End of school day** we request that at the end of the day parents, carers etc don't open the gates and come on site until **3.20pm** Staff could be teaching PE/Games lessons outside. This ensures that we don't have people wandering around the site when our children are outside. This does not apply to the staggered collecting of Reception children.
- 3. If you need to come to the school during the day to inform Mrs Rae or Mrs Maughan or myself of a matter, you MUST come via the entrance near the School Office.
- 4. Internal door outside school office are controlled electronically. Please note that you won't just be able to go down the corridor unless you have been given permission by me or my Office staff. You must see Admin staff first.
- 5. Please do not allow your children to climb or swing on the Early Years red railings. Keep children behind the white line and do not allow them to climb the ramp or steps. This also applies to the railing near the main entrance.
