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Exciting News for GPFS!

Dear Parents

We wanted to keep you up to date as much as possible with the good news this week which some of you may have seen in the Chronicle.

Newcastle City Council's Cabinet have agreed funding in principle for the future expansion and remodelling of Gosforth Park First School as part of the wider school places programme. The GPFS future expansion is obviously still dependent upon the timeline and progress on a number of other factors, particularly gaining full planning approval for the new school at Newcastle Great Park to enable Broadway East First School's relocation

We will in due course need to consider the processes involved in any future expansion and remodelling and this will be subject to consultation with our community and stakeholders accordingly, but as and when we have more information to share, we will pass this on. In the interim, we are working to the outline timescale that we hope to move to two forms of entry in September 2020 and will begin remodelling and expanding into the Broadway East site from this time forward.

This is a very exciting time for our children, the school and the community and we are very much looking forward to the opportunity this will hopefully provide to build upon the success of Gosforth Park First School.
