


Nursery November 2019



Parent Pay and Tapestry – Please could parents ensure they have signed up to Parent Pay and have given permission for Tapestry Online Learning Journey. Staff have already uploaded lots of observations and photos for each child's learning journey, but we need all parental permissions completed before we can start sharing these with you.



Themes – Light and Dark



This half term we'll be learning about light and dark, shadows and reflections by exploring and experimenting with torches, the light box and overhead projector. We'll start by reading the story 'This is the Bear and the Scary Night', but will also be learning about Bonfire Night and Diwali, and have lots of lovely stories about these too. We'll be introducing some great information books to help us learn about all of these topics.

Friday 15th November – Children In Need Day – We'll join in with lots of Pudsey-themed activities, and will talk about ways we can help those in need.

Zoolab visit – Friends of Gosforth Park PTA have very kindly funded a visit from Zoolab for a Christmas treat! They will join in with a fantastic animal handling workshop with a Nativity themed story.

Coats and Bags - We are encouraging children to be independent when putting on and taking off coats, but it can be difficult when children have bags on their pegs too. Please only leave a bag if your child really needs it. As the weather is getting colder, could we ask that you put hats and gloves/mittens in your child's drawer at the start of each session, for them to put on when we go outside. It can take such a long time to help with lots of pairs of gloves, so if you can provide mittens instead, we'd be really grateful! **Thank you!**




