

#### Attendance

Next week, we will be sharing your child's individual attendance data with you. We know that attendance has been impacted by both COVID absences and other genuine illnesses, however, it is important for us to share this information with you as we are required by the LA to monitor attendance below 90%.

Attendance should be 97% or above. We use a traffic light system for attendance

- Attendance above 97% Green (Safety Zone)
- Attendance between 91% and 96% -Amber (At Risk Zone)
- Attendance below 90% Red (Danger Zone)

The report will show how many sessions (not days) of absence your child has had. There are two sessions per day.

If we can support with attendance in any way, please get in touch. Our attendance officer, Clare Gardner, will be happy to help.

Please remember, I cannot authorise any absence due to family holidays. I can only authorise leave in exceptional circumstances.
