Safeguarding on the Day and Health and Safety

As part of the protocols we will require all visitors to sign in and take a visitor sticker and write their name on it plus their child's class. I will have staff on hand at the entrance gates with clip boards etc. to do this. Your patience and support with this will be much appreciated. No buggies will be allowed in the school building. If you need to bring one then it will have to be parked under the canopy outside. You will appreciate for health and safety reasons we do not have room inside.

Fire Alarm – If this goes off it will not be a drill, it could be a false alarm but everyone will be expected to behave in a calm, sensible, quiet manner, walk not run. The Fire Alarm is one very loud continuous bell. Staff, children and parents will vacate the building by the nearest exit and must line up in classes on the top playground which is our Fire Assembly Point.
