Viewing your child's work on Monday 3rd April

Protocols:

Please note that the times for this must be adhered to and your support will be appreciated:

As advised in your appointment letter you will have the opportunity to share your child's work with them and if you have any queries you can raise these at your meeting with your child's class teacher. This will take place in the morning from = 9.05am – 10.20am (after registration). Mrs Wilson and I will re-open the doors near the entrance areas to the KS1 & KS2 classrooms at 9.05 so that you can collect your child. Miss Smith will open the door at the Early Years entrance for Reception parents. If you are late then you will have to come to the entrance near the School Office.

The afternoon session is from 2.30pm – 3.15pm. The OSC will need access to the hall hence 3.15pm end time. You will enter school via the School Office. After you have finished you have my permission to take your child home. However you must inform your child's teacher.

KS2 - You can collect your child from their class. They will have their drawer with their work and you are invited to go to the school hall or the ICT suite or Library area and let them share their work with you. When you have finished please go with them to return their drawer to class.

KS1 - You can collect your child from their class. They will have their drawer with their work and you are invited to go to the school hall or Library area or outside my office and let them share their work with you. When you have finished please go with them to return their drawer to class.

Reception – You will be able to share your child's work with them in their classroom. The area near the Early Years entrance will also be available. When you have finished please go with them to return their drawer to class.

For those of you with siblings then I know that you will be well organised and collect your children appropriately.

The afternoon will be very busy but if everyone is calm and sensible then it should be a happy successful afternoon.

Why are grown-ups always saying that?

Well, imagine you're a car. After a long night of **sleeping**, your fuel tank is empty. Breakfast is the fuel that gets you going so you can hit the road!

The following foods are all great ingredients for a healthy breakfast.

Fruit and vegetables: all fruit and vegetables that are fresh, tinned, dried, frozen or in juice form are good for you. (Just be careful of things like tinned peaches in syrup as these are higher in sugar than those in their own juice.)

Starchy foods: bread (especially wholemeal), rice and cereals (especially wholegrain) that are lower-sugar and lower-salt.

Milk and dairy: cheese, low-fat yoghurt and lower-fat milk.

Non-dairy protein: meat, fish, eggs, beans and unsalted nuts.
