- Hair brush/comb
- No deodorants/sprays or shampoo.

Long hair must be tied back and no jewellery (including earrings and watches) is to be worn. These are health and safety rules from the pool to keep everyone safe.

Lessons will be from 1:30 – 2:45.

Children will be walking to and from the pool, leaving school at 12:55 and then back again, leaving the pool at 3:00 and returning to school for the end of the day.

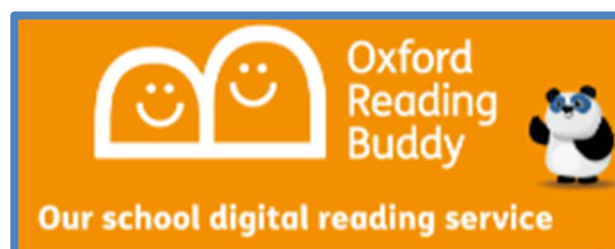
Orange class are now our 'Mathletes of the Week' after coming very close before the holidays – well done to you all!
