Are you getting stuck in a rut with packed lunches? It can be hard to vary the lunches each day, especially for fussy eaters, but it's worth assessing a typical lunch box by checking labels to see how much nutrition and also unhealthy fat and sugars we are unknowingly providing as part of our child's daily quota. Try to include at least 1 food from each food group. Vegetables could include a pot of cherry tomatoes (cut in half), cooked beetroot, sweetcorn, sticks of carrot, cucumber, pepper or celery. Stop cut veg sticks from drying out by adding a damp kitchen towel to the pot.

Wearable Technology



We have noticed a huge increase in the number of children coming to school with 'wearable technology' such as fit bits. Wearable Technology that has the ability to communicate, i.e. camera, microphone or message notifications, is not allowed to be worn in school.

If a Wearable Technology device is deemed by the teacher to be causing a distraction around school, it is liable to confiscation until the end of the school day. As with other watches, staff will ask that these are removed before PE.

We advise that these are not worn on swimming days.
